Interesting facts:

Iowa State and Kansas are two of the best 3-point shooting teams in the nation...ISU is third in the nation, connecting on 42.1 percent of its shots from downtown, while KU has made 41.8 percent of its shots from 3-point range to rank fourth nationally.

Marquis Gilstrap has opened the Big 12 season with three-straight double-doubles, averaging 18.0 points and 12.3 rebounds in league action...Gilstrap has a team-high eight double-doubles to rank third in the Big 12.

In last year's meeting vs. KU in Hilton Coliseum, ISU's Craig Brackins tallied a career-high 42 points in the game (11-19 FG; 3-5 3FG; 17-21 FT)
